THE MAGIC OF IMAGINATION IS EXPLORED FOR THE PRESCHOOL CHILD.

Hello, Weather, Let's play together! Sunshine, clouds, snow, rain, wind, storms...Mother Nature offers so many variables. The next semester of Kindermusik Imagine That! takes advantage of those variables to provide three and four-year-olds with a myriad of creative, weather-related musical adventures. Imagine creating musical storm sound with a drum and cymbal. Picture your Kindermusik students exploring the pitter patter of rain and the woosh of the wind. Dance along with jingle bells while gliding along an imaginary ice pond or enjoy throwing pretend snowballs. This unit uses weather as the basis for fun activities while making children more aware of the powers and beauty of the nature around them. The children will create delightful home activity projects like making wind chimes, rain hats, sleigh bells and snow boots. Home materials include a 2 CD set, two literature books, a Home Activity Guide, and two instruments: a pair of Kindermusik Ankle Bells and a Rain Shaker with Scraper.

For your budding musician, **Kindermusik for the Young Child** provides a pressure-free environment and a developmentally appropriate experience where musical growth can take place before taking on more formal instruction in elementary school choirs, bands or orchestras. During the fall semester of **Young Child 1** your child will develop the greatest instrument - the voice - while learning the symbols and vocabulary of music making. Your child will also learn instrumental skills by playing his/her own glockenspiel. Listening activities are designed to strengthen your child's ability to discern a variety of musical styles and instruments. Through creative learning activities, your child will begin to gain a knowledge of composers and their music, how to read music and create musical compositions - tangible accomplishments that instill positive emotions about his/her own musicality.
